

Manage the admissions of children to school, who do not have a school place and meet the Fair Access Protocol criteria. The team provide advice, support and guidance to schools, parents and governors. The team give advice about the exclusion process and signpost schools when a pupil is at risk of exclusion. The team commission places for children who have been permanently excluded, require support when they are at risk of exclusion.

They also support children who have health needs, which impact on their ability to attend school.

Intensive Planning Team

The Intensive Planning Team work with identified children and young people with SEND who are at high risk of their education placement breaking down and/or at risk of needing an independent, residential school, away from their families and community.
